HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

We do not seek any kind of financial profit however our students are asked to buy their own books and make a small deposit. This deposit is refunded in full at the end of the course if the student attend at least **70%** of classes.

Classes are held on various venues such as community centres, libraries, churches, schools and cafes.



WHAT IS OUR METHODOLOGY?

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?

The courses are divided into levels, from beginners up to pre-intermediate. At each level students will study for 30 hours spread over three or four months, depending on the amount of classes given per week.
